JCC's Elder Rehab Program for Memory-Impaired Individuals has Openings

The Tucson Jewish Community Center's physical fitness and cognitive stimulation program for memory-impaired older adults is actively recruiting participants for its fall 2015 program. Memory-impaired seniors are paired with U of A student volunteers, and enjoy twice-weekly 2-hour sessions of supervised physical exercise and memory- and language-stimulation activities and games. The program is based on a federally-funded U of A treatment research project directed by psychologist and SAPA member Sharon Arkin, who is directing the JCC's program as a volunteer. The fall program has openings for 10-15 new participants. Applicants should be ambulatory (cane or walker ok), continent, able to communicate understandably (repetitiveness ok), able to obtain physician consent to participate, be unable to drive or travel independently, and have reliable transportation to and from the JCC (3800 E. River Rd. @ Dodge).
